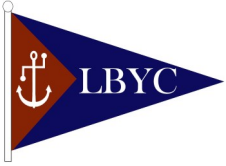


Friday Night Bell Ringer

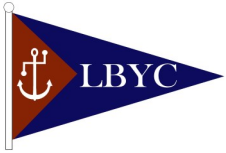
